Please be aware that this schedule will be used as a guideline and is not written in stone.

Be prepared to accept any changes presented.

General Regulations

1. Report any & all illnesses to a chaperone immediately.
2. Do not provide medicine of any sort to yourself or any member of our group.
3. Any medications must be turned in to the chaperones in a prescription bottle with a signed note from your parent.
4. Needless to say... have fun... do your best... you can be as good as you can possibly be!!
5. Do not separate yourself from the group during or after meals. Remember to let a chaperone know if you need to go somewhere, at all times. This is for your safety; we want to make sure you have a safe and fun trip.
6. If for some reason you do get separated from the group, students should contact Mr. Lane or a chaperone who will make arrangements to meet the separated student.

Bus Conduct

- There is to be a minimum of movement while bus is in motion. Stay in your seats as much as possible.
- LOUD singing and LOUD talking will not be acceptable.
- ALL trash and paper will be put into plastic bags located in front of each bus.
- Be certain of all bus departure times and be on the bus 5 minutes before time of roll call.
- No practicing on the bus unless so authorized by the band director.
- Do not sit on the arms or lean over backs of the seats at any time on the bus.
- Bring Cookies or snacks to share with the people on the bus, they will love you for it.
- Chaperones have to right to move boy-girl bus seats to boy-boy and girl-girl after dark.
