Rehearsals and Performances- 100 pts See the column on the right for further information. Partial rehearsal or performance- 10 pt deduction every 10 minutes. Until 70, then a grade of 65 after 30 minutes late. Missing a full rehearsal is a zero. Communication is essential. Work is not an excuse, but I do my best to work with student athletes. Tardiness to warm-up, leaving early, not being prepared with necessary materials... Performances are not complete until the last performer or group is finished performing and all items used are returned to their proper place. Leaving a concert early will result in the grade as stated above. There are no exceptions. This will be strictly enforced. Playing and/or Written Examinations- 30% **Concerts/ Performances - 30%** o Includes-District/State Auditions and **Participation** During the 1<sup>st</sup> 9 weeks when there is no performance, playing and written exams count 50% and rehearsal skills count 50%.
