After-school rehearsals are required of all students in preparation for the performances. There is a class fee for this class of \$85. Class Grading for Assignments and Assessments

All grades in this class will be classified by the following:

- Rehearsal Skills 40%
 - Class- Weekly participation grades will be given.
 - O Rehearsals and Performances- 100 pts
 - Partial rehearsal or performance- 10 pt deduction every 10 minutes. Until 70, then a grade of 65 after 30 minutes late. Missing a full rehearsal is a zero. Communication is essential. Work is not an excuse, but I do my best to work with student athletes.
 - Tardiness to warm-up, leaving early, not being prepared with necessary materials...
 - Performances are not complete until the last performer or group is finished performing and all items used are returned to their proper place. Leaving a concert early will result in the grade as stated above. There are no exceptions. This will be strictly enforced.
- Playing and/or Written Examinations- 30%
- Concerts/ Performances 30%
 - o Includes-District/State Auditions and Participation
 - During the 1st 9 weeks when there is no performance, playing and written exams count 50% and rehearsal skills count 50%.

Extra credit is only offered at various times throughout the year. Please stay on top of all grades to ensure you are earning the points that you have worked hard for throughout the 9 weeks.

All students are expected to practice regularly for this course. We will have assignments using smartmusic as well as various other practice assignments. Please adhere to all deadlines.

All students are encouraged to take private lessons. While this is not required, private lessons give students the opportunity to receive more individualized attention on their instrument and become more technically proficient

 An Absent comment code in the gradebook represents that the student was absent and needs to submit the assignment, and the grade is currently calculated as a zero. An Exempt comment code in the gradebook represents that the student is exempt from the assignment, and the grade is not calculated in the overall average. A Late comment code represents that the assignment has been graded and entered with the penalty calculated (per Late Work policy in Course Expectations). A Missing comment code in the gradebook represents the assignment was not turned in and currently is calculated as a zero. A Needs Improvement comment means the assignment was not completed well enough to earn a grade. These will be calculated as zero until completed satisfactorily.
